**Drop Offs**— Please be prompt if your drop off/pick up times are outside of the full day (8am—6pm).

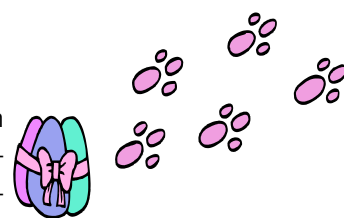
## Students
